apprehension (n.) uneasiness; dread; anxiety; suspicion; concern; worry  
 cower (v.) crouch or shrink away from in fear and shame; grovel  
 cringe (v.) recoil; cower; flinch; grovel

 awe (n.) respect and wonder; mixed feeling of terror, panic, and wonder

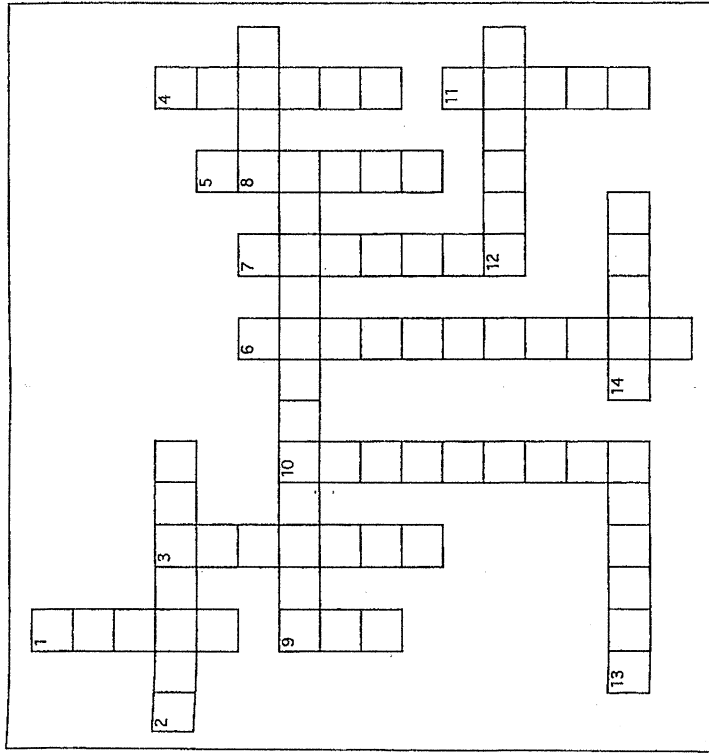
